Mageswari de Queen Mary's College (y afiliada a la Universidad de Madras) defendió su tesis doctoral en setiembre sobre el tema " Agua y acceso a servicios salubres entre las mujeres de los suburbios de la ciudad de Chennai: Un estudio analítico" . El proyecto exploraba el impacto de los servicios públicos en cuatro grupos de comunidades e implicaba entrevistas a 800 mujeres así como métodos de GPS y GIS para localizar y mapear nueve ejemplos de suburbios y sus recursos. Pretende contribuir a repensar las políticas y los planes de estrategias de desarrollo en estas áreas e intentar que se tengan en cuenta las consideraciones de género y geográficas.
