Prof. Martin Bell has resigned for retirement while Prof. Piguet, Yeoh and Shen have to step out according to IGU statute. Dr Nikola Sander has decided to resign as secretary but wishes to remain in the committee. Prof. Darren Smith has kindly accepted to step in as chair for the next period. Other members have been contacted and are considering to step in as vice-chair. Prof. Charles-Edwards Elin (Australia) enters the committee on Jan. 1st and replace Prof. Bell.
