The table identifies 47 people who came at least twice since 2015 (see the table). These data show a decrease in participation compared to previous years, because of the commission's conference being held online in 2020 due to COVID19 confinement. Colleagues who usually attend face-to-face conferences on this occasion did not participate. On the other hand, it was considered appropriate to limit the number of participants to 30 papers in order to organize a program avoiding parallel sessions. Among these

47 people, 20 attended participated three times or more, 19 attended four times or more. They constitute the core of the Urban commission. These 47 members come from 20 countries and contribute and participate very actively to the commission's debates.

In total, more than 400 different people attended our own meetings between 2015 and 2020 at least once, coming from a total of 48 different countries (not counting each person several times).

A3. Commission mailing list

The commission mailing list (iguurban@unil.ch) counts 1'077 subscribers (December 2020). It is not possible to obtain their location by country as far as many of them have international email addresses.

A4. Young scholar support

Since 2019, the Commission provides grants to help defray the costs of young participation to the Conference. Please note that, due to limited availability of funds, the IGU Travel Grants will provide only the contribution to registration. In 2020 the grant was awarded to 8 researchers.

B. MEETINGS

Since 2016, we introduced a new procedure asking for extended abstracts (3 to 5 pages) and the steering committee together with the young scholar committee and local colleagues evaluate them with 2 reviewers for each paper. The result is highly appreciated, improving the quality of papers. We will continue to improve this procedure over the coming years.
